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### Terms and Conditions of Internship

#### 1. Purpose of the Internship

- Internship Project provides an opportunity to young individuals to expose themselves to cutting edge research in legal ideology and its scope in the Judiciary Decisions. It best suits individuals who have studied in college recently and wish to move on to pursue Ph. D. in Law or related fields, or to positions in government research institutions, or legal institutions that require a quantitative and analytic orientation.

#### 2. Participant's Duties /Responsibilities /Obligations toward ILE:

- ILE follows Zero Tolerance policy for Plagiarism. Authors are requested to submit only their original works, and will appropriately cite or quote the work and/or words of others. Plagiarism content will be eliminated by editorial board automatically;
- The credits of the work derived from the work of others should be given to that person. It is often better to avoid this. Merely citing the source does not eliminate the Plagiarism automatically.

#### 3. Plagiarism Policy of ILE

Plagiarism for ILE is the act of copying other person's ideas, words or work and pretending that are your own; something that has been copied in this way, ILE will never allow it anywhere. It also means translation from one language to another for committing plagiarism. The ILE will use Plagiarism Checker X software for Detecting plagiarism.

#### **4. Zero Tolerance Policy**

The core work carried out by the Participant shall be based on original ideas and shall be covered by Zero Tolerance Policy on Plagiarism. The core work shall include abstract with keywords, introduction, objective, hypothesis, research methodology, analysis and interpretation, summary and observations, conclusions, recommendations and references. If ILE found more than 40% of plagiarism in any document, we will report it to the competent/designated officer of Plagiarism Disciplinary Authority. The authorities of HEI will take suo moto notice of an act of plagiarism and initiate proceedings under these regulations. Similarly proceedings can also be initiated by the HEI on the basis of findings of an examiner.

#### **5. COPYRIGHT POLICY OF ILE**

All rights of the Submission of participant's research works are reserve with Institute of Legal Education. No part of the material published on this website (iledu.in) (Articles or Research Papers including those published in Institute of Legal Review) should be reproduced, distributed or transmitted in any form or by any means, including photocopying, recording, or other electronic or mechanical methods, without the prior written permission of the publisher, except in the case of brief quotations embodied in critical reviews and certain other non-commercial uses permitted by copyright law. Once the author or participant's manuscripts or any material for the publication is published in ILE, it will become ILE property. If the plagiarism found in post publication of manuscripts, the author is only responsibility for that issue. Plagiarized content will not be the property of ILE. #### **Internship Guidelines**

- Internship Participants shall prepare 4 case commentaries between the period of Internship (8 Weeks).
- In the Internship Period, participants must prepare a case commentaries per 2 week (Totally 4 Case Commentaries)
- Case Commentaries may be returned to the author with suggestions related to substance and/or style. Final acceptance of a manuscript for publication is contingent on the incorporation of such suggestions to the satisfaction. If it is not satisfactory, it will be rejected.
- Every two Week participants should submit their Case Commentaries in the provided submission link.

- The Cases for the Internship will be shared by the Whatsapp Group.
- Participants' qualified Case Commentaries will be published with a publication certificate in the ILE Constitutional Review at the free of cost. If more than one author drafts a case, Top draft will be published in Journal and remaining will be published in ILE Legal Blog. Hard Copy of Certificate available at the request of Participants
- Certificate of Internship completion and letter of Recommendation will be given to the participants after the successful completion of Internship.
- If you need any help relating to the internship or blog article theme, you can ask your queries to the organizers at any time.
- Maximum of Internship communication will be dealt in Whatsapp and Email.
- Internship is Fully unpaid internship.

## **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

### **I. General Guidelines**

- ✚ Case Commentary Draft must be accompanied by an **ABSTRACT** not exceeding 300 words.
- ✚ All works must be original and unpublished, and must not be pending for review before any other journal. Any form of plagiarism will result in immediate **DISQUALIFICATION** from the competition.

### **II. Manuscript Format**

- ✚ The main body of the manuscript should be in **TIMES NEW ROMAN** style, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing.
- ✚ Footnotes in Times New Roman Style, Size 10, with 1.0 line spacing.
- ✚ All headings must have uniform formatting.
- ✚ All entries should be submitted in .doc or .docx and .pdf format.
- ✚ Texts and footnotes should conform to the **BLUEBOOK 20TH EDITION**.
- ✚ If draft failed to adhere Manuscript Format Guidelines, **IT WILL BE REJECTED**.

### **III. Heading Format**

- ✚ Each heading in the body of the article must be numbered.
- ✚ The main headings should be numbered I, II, III and so on.
- ✚ The second level of headings should be numbered A, B, C, and so on.
- ✚ Both the first and second levels of headings should have the first letter of the main words capitalized.
- ✚ The third level of headings should be numbered 1, 2, 3 and so on.
- ✚ The fourth level of headings should be numbered (i), (ii), (iii) and so on.
- ✚ The third and fourth level of headings should have only the first letter of the heading capitalized.

**IV. CASE COMMENTARY (1500-2000 words excluding footnotes)**

For **CASE COMMENTARY CATEGORIES MANUSCRIPT** must have Followings in their Manuscripts:

- ✚ Title of Paper
- ✚ Abstract (Give a Brief note about that How this Case is important to us and Not exceeding 300 Words)
- ✚ Keywords (Minimum 5)
- ✚ Involved Acts and Sections
- ✚ Judgement Couse Title
- ✚ Case Number
- ✚ Judgement Date
- ✚ Court
- ✚ Quorum

-  Author and citation (Which Judges Authored the Judgement)
-  Introduction and Background of Judgement
-  Fact and Issue
-  Both Parties Argument
-  Judgement
-  Conclusion
-  Reference (If any)
-  Related Cases Laws (Min. 5)
